Step 2:

Enter your First Name, Last Name, School, and Email.

(**Note:** Enter the email that you want to use to sign into the site. The Auto Upkeep Wiki uses “Google Sites”, so if you already have an email address that is associated with a “Google Account”, use that email address. This doesn’t have to be Google “gmail” account. If you are not already a “Google Account” holder, use the email that you want to associate with The Auto Upkeep Wiki.)

Step 3:

Wait for an email to come into your inbox from info@autoupkeep.com. The title of the email will be “Auto Upkeep Wiki - The Collaborative Resource Site for Teachers”. Check your junk email folder if this doesn’t come into your Inbox. This email has to be manually checked and approved by Mike, so this isn’t instantaneous.

(**Note:** If you don’t receive this email within 24 hours, please email Mike directly at info@autoupkeep.com and ask to become a member of The Auto Upkeep Wiki. Mike needs to check the system to make sure only teachers are given access, since all the tests are posted on this site.)




